Kindergarten to Year 2 Student Agreement

Using the computer is a big responsibility and I am going to agree to be a good computer user.

I want to be a good technology user

- I will have clean and gentle hands when I use the computers, iPads, tablets and laptops.
- I won't change the settings on the iPads including home screen, text size etc
- I will ask for help when I don't know what to do.
- I will share the computer, tablets and iPads with classmates.
- I know that teachers might look at what I do on the computer, tablet or the iPad.
- I will not tell anyone my password.

When I use the internet

- I will tell my parents about the things I do on the internet.
- I will stay on the web pages my teacher shows me.
- I won't download apps without my teacher's permission.
- I won't tell people on the internet who I am or where I live.
- I will tell my teacher and my parents if I see something on the internet that makes me feel uncomfortable.

Personal technology at school: During events such as Talent Quest preparation, parents may give permission for students to bring a phone/iPad/mp3 player to school:

- It will be brought into the classroom every morning and put on the teacher's desk or wherever the teacher has allocated a space
- It will be switched off during the day and collected at the end of the day by the student
- All of the above user agreement rules also apply to my phone
- The phones/iPads/mp3 players may be taken out with permission during recess and lunch.
- The school takes no responsibility for any damage or loss of phones/iPads/mp3 players on school property

I understand that students breaking these rules will be subject to appropriate action by the school. This may include the loss of internet and network services access for some time, as determined by the Principal.
